  - 3. "You're Doing It at a High Level" Recognize exceptional effort

- BSAAFWYW Be Specific and Ask for What You Want
- Other Ways to Ask for More Beyond BSAAFWYW
- **Handling Defensiveness** Responding to pushback effectively

- **Leadership Scenarios** Small groups role-play real leadership challenges
- **School Group Reflection** Action planning for implementation
- **Closing Story & Final Takeaways** Leadership is about moments, choices, and action; and you are enough for the task!
